Stenn's wonderful new duet "Periphery" traces the edge of the stage in a band of light. Resonant gestures suggest a relationship, now tentative, now tempestuous. The choreographer's poetic ensemble piece "Blue Print" also gets a reprise, minus its T. S. Eliot voice-overs. For both pieces, the bassist Jay Weissman and the cellist Dave Eggar play live, and in the latter, joined by violinist Rachel Golub, they're very much part of the dance.
